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National Truth and Reconciliation (Orange Shirt Day)

On September 30, OCDSB students and staff will mark the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day.





This is a day of mourning and remembrance for Indigenous people. This date also offers an opportunity to reflect and to honour residential school survivors, their families, and communities.

We also commit to continued teaching and learning about the history and legacy of residential schools.

Within the school we provide a wide variety of experiences for our staff and students to learn together about the significance of the day as well as celebrating Indigenous Excellence.

Rowan's Law Day

On September 30th we also recognized Rowan's Law Day by discussing the signs and symptoms of a concussion with our students, educating them about dangers of concussions.

What is Rowan's Law? On March 7, 2018, Ontario passed Rowan's Law (Concussion Safety), and related amendments to the Education Act. Transportation Pick up/Drop off Information

The Ottawa Student Transportation Authority continues to look for drivers. We are fortunate to be able to share that at this time our yellow bus is running! Thank you for your continued patience as OSTA. If you are dropping off or picking up your child from in front of our school (Gloucester St.) please be aware that you must not leave your vehicle unattended for 2 minutes or more. If your vehicle is left unattended bylaw may ticket. Also supervision only begins at 8:40am. Please do not drop your child off in the yard prior to this as there is no supervision.



We are working with the city to rezone this portion of the road as a "kiss and ride" location to allow more flexibility. In the meantime, should you wish to drop off or pick up and are required to stop for more than 2 minutes please park in one of the permissible parking spaces across the street.

Breakfast Club is back!

Centennial Public School's Breakfast Club is back up and running. The club will continue to offer breakfast at the parking lot doors in the morning to any who would like to participate. Students who need breakfast are to come to the parking lot doors between 8:40-8:55 to meet with Ms. Helena to pick up their bagged breakfast.

Students without lunch, you are in luck! The PSP classes are delivering bags with extra lunch items to each class daily. We ask that students ensure all garbage is put into their school bags and brought home each day to help reduce waste.
